Harvest Report: 2011 was a very cool summer compared to normal. Consistent rain and colder temperatures pushed back budbreak. Flowering occurred as normal in early June with near perfect weather. The growing season was cool and fogs prevalent. During the first two weeks of September, the fog began to retreat as temperatures rose with lovely weather. Early October was marked by two significant rainfall events. Only after the second half of October did a drier, warmer pattern begin again. The outstanding quality our fruit is attributed to patience waiting for ripeness and good weather.
